Scholarship Criteria – Applicant Must:

- Provide a cumulative high school transcript through the most recent term. (Non-traditional not applicable).
- Have a 2.5 or higher GPA. (Non-traditional not applicable).
- Submit an up-to-two-page typewritten essay describing how applicant's community volunteerism has helped make her community a better place. If applicant had the opportunity to volunteer with Alexis, please share this in the essay.

This scholarship is renewable. A Student may receive this scholarship more than one academic year. Student will need to re-apply each academic year to qualify.
