

The Dr. Keitha S. Griffith Nursing Scholarship Fund Criteria

This non-renewable advanced nursing scholarship was established by the by her family to honor the life, legacy and memory of Dr. Keitha S. Griffith.

The purpose of the Fund is to provide educational opportunities in the form of scholarship assistance awards to students who have a BSN (Bachelor of Science in Nursing), are pursuing either a Master of Science in Nursing or a Doctorate of Nursing degree, and who meet the eligibility and scholarship application criteria.

Preference will be given to students who are pursuing advanced nursing degrees at the University of Central Arkansas, the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, or the University of Arkansas at Monticello.

Eligibility Criteria -

Criteria to be used by the Advisory Committee in selection of recipients shall include academic merit, character and financial need. Recipients must have a college grade point average of 3.0 or better.

Scholarship Application Criteria –

- Completed and submitted online scholarship application.
- Cumulative college transcript through the most recent term.
- Two letters of recommendation: one from a school official and one from an adult other than a family member or employer.
- In your own words, a single page typewritten essay on the importance of pursuing advanced nursing degree.
