

DR. CARL F. HARTMANN ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP FUND

This non-renewable scholarship was established by his parents in memory and honor of Dr. Carl F. Hartmann, and is awarded annually to at least one Union County Arkansas high school senior who plans to pursue a career in engineering.

Eligibility Criteria

A recipient must be a candidate for graduation from high school in El Dorado, AR, or, as an alternative, from Union County Arkansas School during the academic year in which the scholarship is awarded. The recipient should exhibit both promise and interest in the field of engineering and be in the top one-third of his or her graduating class.

Application Requirements

- Scholarship application.
- Cumulative high school or college transcript through the most recent term. (Must include ACT or SAT score).
- Two letters of recommendation: one from a school official and one from an adult other than a family member.
- Essay relating the student's career goals in engineering.
