

PROCTOR HILL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP TO THE UNIVERSITY OF THE SOUTH AT SEWANEE, TENNESSEE

This renewable scholarship established in memory of Jesse Proctor Hill, Jr., is awarded annually to at least one graduating senior from El Dorado High School, El Dorado, Arkansas **and is currently available to meet the full cost of tuition, room and board** for a full-time student obtaining a 4-year degree (criteria for annual renewal are provided upon scholarship award); the full amount of the scholarship award will depend upon several factors including other scholarships the student may receive.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicant must be a graduating El Dorado High School senior who is currently a resident of El Dorado, Arkansas and who has been continually enrolled in the El Dorado School District since October 1st of the ninth grade or before. The scholarship is awarded based on financial need, academic merit, and length of attendance in the El Dorado School District. Length of attendance in the El Dorado School District and the maximum percentage of scholarship benefit are in tandem with the El Dorado Promise.

Applications for this scholarship must include a letter of acceptance to the applicant from the University of the South at Sewanee, Tennessee.

Students applying for the Sewanee scholarship through UCCF should demonstrate that he or she has applied to the University of the South for scholarship(s) the University has available. Failure to qualify for a scholarship from the University of the South will not disqualify a student from receiving this scholarship.

Application Requirements:

- ◆ Submitted online scholarship application and Sewanee letter of acceptance.
- ◆ Cumulative high school transcript through the most recent term and information on class ranking (Must include ACT or SAT score and GPA).
- ◆ Two letters of recommendation: one from a school official and one from an adult other than a family member.
- ◆ A one to two page typewritten essay to include: (1) an explanation on why applicant merits this scholarship; (2) information that would assist the advisory committee in understanding the need for financial assistance; and, (3) a statement regarding applicant's educational plans and how they relate to career goals.
