

HAZEL C. AND LESTER C. ROSS SCHOLARSHIP FUND

This non-renewable scholarship was established in memory and honor of former El Dorado High School Coach L. C. Ross. The scholarship is awarded annually to at least one El Dorado High School Senior of African-American heritage.

Eligibility Criteria

A recipient must be a candidate for graduation from high school during the academic year in which the scholarship is awarded, and have a GPA no lower than a 2.5. Criteria to be used by the Advisory Committee in selection of recipients shall include but not be limited to financial need and academic merit.

The following, along with a signed cover page, must be returned to Union County Community Foundation by April 3rd.

- ◆ **One** cumulative high school transcript through the most recent term (only one need be official; the others can be copies).
- ◆ **Two** letters of recommendation: one from a school official and one from an adult other than a family member.
- ◆ **One** typewritten essay (one or two pages) that relates the student's educational and career goals.
