

Thomas F. Meeks Jr. Law School Scholarship

This scholarship was established in memory of Thomas F. Meeks, Jr., by his sister, and is awarded to at least one recipient who is a graduate of a Union County high school. The scholarship is renewable and criteria for renewal is provided upon scholarship award.

Eligibility Criteria

Selection of recipients will apply to students who have graduated from high school in Union County, Arkansas. The Fund's priority is to provide a scholarship to students who wish to pursue a post-graduate degree in Arkansas. Applicants choosing law school will be given preference. Criteria used by the Advisory Committee in selection of recipients shall include but not be limited to financial need, academic performance, recommendations from instructors, and leadership ability.

Application Information

Availability for new applicants varies for this renewable scholarship. When the scholarship is available, applications will be accepted via the UCCF online scholarship application portal in the late spring. Application Requirements

- ◆ Completed on-line application
- ◆ A cumulative college or law school transcript through the most recent term (an official transcript will be required if scholarship is awarded).
- ◆ Financial Information Summary. The summary should include a brief explanation of the applicant's household income and expenses.
- ◆ Two Letters of Recommendation: one from a college instructor, and one from an adult other than a family member
- ◆ One-Two page essay (See online application for details)
